For us, for you, and for future generations, we are doing everything we can to minimize the impact of our activities on the environment.

That's why we have implemented the following actions:

We raise awareness among our teams and our clients

We are committed to raising awareness among our teams and clients about the issues of sustainable tourism, environmental preservation, and corporate social responsibility (CSR). Our teams are trained in eco-friendly practices to follow in their daily tasks. We choose our service providers and suppliers based on their sustainable commitments.

You will find information available regarding the natural sites nearby and the best practices to adopt for preserving wildlife and flora.

We have set up displays to facilitate waste sorting in accordance with local regulations – you will find sorting bins available in both buildings!

We save water and energy

We have installed water-saving devices and pressure reducers on taps, showers, and toilets to avoid exhausting our precious water resources.

Bedding and sheets are changed every three days and upon your departure, but you can request shorter intervals at the reception.

The temperature of your room is regulated before your arrival.

We replace every light bulb with LED bulbs and have already equipped over 90% of our lighting.

We have installed presence detectors/timers in our common areas to limit unnecessary consumption.

We limit and sort our waste

We have set up several selective sorting points, from basic waste to hazardous waste.
... and that's not all!

We prepare vegetarian meals upon request. We choose seasonal local products and adapt to various dietary restrictions.

Our breakfast offerings and restaurant menu feature organic products and those from fair trade, especially local! The cleaning products used in the rooms are mostly eco-labeled, providing better air quality and less risk to your health and that of our wonderful housekeeping staff.

Here's how you can participate in our initiative!

- Report any water leaks,
- Turn off lights, the television, and air conditioning when you leave your room,
- Turn off the air conditioning if you open a window,
- Use water rationally in the bathroom,
- Leave on the floor only the towels that need to be washed,
- Leave visible cans, glass or plastic bottles, and used batteries on the desk,
- Use the sorting bins available to you,
- Let's fight together against food waste at breakfast.
